After some suggestions we would like to trial a quick lunch deposit box for the rest of term 3, and if successful fully implement the box into the new canteen set up.

As from Monday 5th August, you will be able to drop your completed lunch / afternoon tea order directly into the secure box as an alternative to ordering at the window.

So things can run smoothly, here are the rules to follow:

Make sure you have an up to date menu, month and year is on the top.

Please clearly fill out your order with the required information (can be written on a lunch bag or piece of paper)

- Child's name
- Child's class
- Lunch order (Label with "L")
- Afternoon tea order (Label with "A/T")
- Total amount
- Amount enclosed

We recommend enclosing in a envelope or zip bag to keep money safe.

If your order requires change, this will be returned to your child with their order.

If you accidentally have the wrong pricing, we will supply as much of the order as possible and the change returned to your child with the order.

We thank you for your co-operation during the trial process and hope this will assist some families.

Dear Parents/Carers,

Nationally consistent collection of data on school students with disability – 2019

Our school is participating in the collection of nationally consistent data on school students with disability.

We will be collecting information already available in the school about the support that is being provided to students with disability. Better data will help the Government plan for students with disability.

The data collection will have no direct impact on your child/ren and they will not be involved in any testing process.

The NSW Department of Education will provide data to the Australian Government from all NSW public schools in such a way that no individual student or school will be able to be identified. In this way, we will ensure the privacy and confidentiality of all students.

All information is protected by privacy laws which regulate the collection, storage and disclosure of personal information. If you have any questions regarding this process or do not want your child/ren to be counted in the data collection, please contact the school and notify Mr Brett Agnew or Mrs Sheridan Guilford . A decision to exclude your child/ren will not affect the support they currently receive, or may receive in the future.

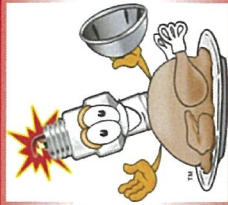
